There are a number of pleasant lounge areas and dining rooms throughout the home. One of the lounges is fitted with a hearing loop, a discreet device to improve sound reception and aid those with hearing difficulties.

There are pleasant, wheelchair accessible gardens and a patio area to the rear of the home with tables and chairs.









## Food for thought...

Dining is a social occasion here at Ingersley Court and our dining rooms are warm and welcoming. Residents are encouraged to eat in the dining rooms but they can choose to eat in their room if they wish. We encourage friends and family to join us for meals with prior arrangement or afternoon tea at anytime. The tables are laid with fresh flowers and linen and our menus are on display to show the choices available. We also cater for special celebrations for our residents such as birthdays and anniversaries.

Our menus consist of home-cooked, nutritionally balanced meals prepared in our own kitchen and made from quality ingredients. Menus are prepared in consultation with our dietician, with input from our residents, to ensure that cultural and personal preferences are considered, while achieving a balanced nutritious diet. The main meal of the day is served in the evening, with a lighter meal at lunch. All meals offer a choice of menu options. Snacks, fresh fruit and refreshments are available at all times.

# A restful night...

We have a range of rooms with a choice of views, some of which have en suite facilities. Additionally there are communal bathrooms with assisted baths, a shower room and several toilets close to each room.

Residents can choose how they want their rooms decorated, and they are encouraged to personalise them with their own furniture pieces, photos and other mementos to ease the transition, and to further add to the homely atmosphere.

#### Keeping active...

Activities at Ingersley Court are organised by the activity co-ordinator with the involvement of the care teams. These are designed to match residents' interests and include a range of activities, such as hand massage and manicures, arts and crafts, bingo, dominoes, one to one relaxation, reminiscence, quizzes, boat trips on the Macclesfield Canal, coffee mornings, sing-a-longs, karaoke, visiting singers/organists, tombolas, clothes parties and birthday parties. There is also a resident photo library and a residents computer which can be used for internet surfing or sending family emails.

#### Worship...

All religious denominations are recognised and links are maintained with the local churches. Regular church services and Communion are held within the home. The Methodist Church attends the home every third Thursday of each month. Church of England Communion services are held on the first Thursday of each month and the Roman Catholic priest visits every Tuesday.

#### The perfect location

Ingersley Court is within easy reach of Ingersley Vale duck pond and the home enjoys tremendous views of the local landmark, White Nancy. The village also has a number of attractions and facilities including the Bollington Discovery Centre, the Drop-in Centre, an arts centre and Bollington well dressing.

# What else can we offer?

Additional services available to residents include a hairdresser who visits twice a week, and newspaper and magazine deliveries, which are arranged through a local newsagent. These are charged on a weekly basis as used. There is also a shop trolley service for items such as greetings cards, toiletries, drinks and confectionery.

DIRECTIONS: Leave the M6 at Junction17 / Take the A534 to Congleton, joining the A34 towards the Town Centre and Manchester / Leave the A34 on the northside of Congleton and take the A536 to Macclesfield / Follow the route using the A537 through Macclesfield and join the A523 to Bollington / At the second roundabout take the third exit onto the B5090 to Bollington / Proceed – past the monument at Bollington Cross – under a Viaduct and an Aquaduct and follow the sign for Pott Shrigley / At the mini-roundabout, by The New Con Club, turn right onto Church Street / Continue along to Lowther Street (opposite the St John The Baptist Church) / Turn left and Ingersley Court is on the right at the end of the street.
